

Wolverhampton Wheelers Track League Wednesday 16th May 2018

This was the second meeting of the new season and the League is beginning to take shape with the established riders regaining their form and newer, younger riders starting to make an impression after months of hard winter training.

The B three lap Dash resulted in a win for Grace Lister, and in the A event it was a win for Matty Lewis with Ethan Roberts second and Seb Bacon third. The B Points race saw Grace Lister take the lead early on in the race thus taking the maximum points each time she crossed the line. The final sprint gave Will Farmer second place with Ollie Baker third. The A event saw some strong riding from Wheeler Giulio Cervi and Newport rider Charlie Fisher but in the end it was Matty Lewis over the line first followed by Ethan Roberts and Gabby Homer (Cycle Team OnForm).

The traditional finishing race, the 22 Lap Handicap, saw the excitement increase with the B riders working together to hold back the A riders before the Intermediate sprint which on this occasion they failed to do, despite this Grace Lister still managed to get over the line first followed by Matty Lewis and Ethan Roberts. This trio then set the pace this eventually changed to Matty Lewis, Giulio Cervi and Seb Bacon and with two laps to go Matty made his move leaving Giulio to take second and Seb to take third places at the end of the 22 laps.
